Re: Pedicab Meeting

Thank you for meeting with us last Tuesday. I think it was a great opportunity for us to discuss the operation of pedicabs in Central Park and how we can work together.

In the future, we would like to hold another meeting with other pedicab operators as well as the Central Park Police and Park Enforcement Patrol to review the rules we discussed.

Please share the following rules with your operators:

- Pedicab drivers must obey all NYC Parks Department rules and regulations as well as all NYC traffic regulations.
- Pedicabs are not allowed in the recreation lanes or on park pathways. Always use the right lane.
- Pedicabs are not allowed to pick up or drop off passengers in the park except for the following locations – Tavern on the Green, Loeb Boathouse Parking Lot, Cherry Hill, and the 102nd Street Cross Drive.
- No advertising.
- Operators must abide by all traffic laws – stopping at red lights; entering and exiting at appropriate locations.
- We encourage applying for special event permits by the person planning the event. Please call Department of Parks & Recreation Manhattan Special Events at 212-408-0226 or contact the Parks Department website at www.nyc.gov/parks.
